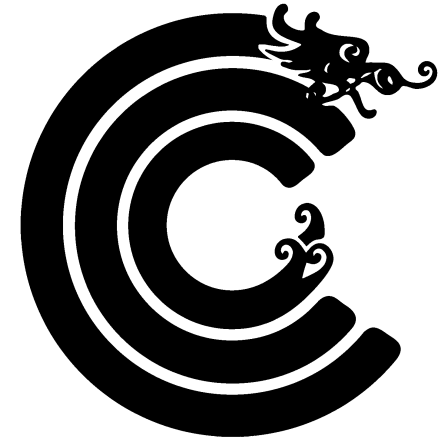

Who is the Chinese Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii?

The Chinese Chamber of Commerce was established in its earliest form in 1911, when a group of young merchants in Honolulu formed the Chinese Merchants' Association. In 1926, the organization changed its name to the Chinese Chamber of Commerce of Honolulu, and shortly thereafter, the name changed to involve all of Hawaii.

The mission of the Chinese Chamber is to promote business and economic development with focus on China and Southeast Asia, to preserve Chinese culture, and to encourage civic responsibility. Many members of the Chamber are leaders in Hawaii's business, professional and legislative communities and play important roles in shaping the State's economic, social and political future.

Significant activities include the Annual Narcissus Festival and Goodwill Tour to China, assistance provided to State of Hawaii agencies to promote commerce, investment, and trade with China and Taiwan, and programs to stimulate growth in our own community.
